PRESS RELEASE

On May 30, 2022 at approximately 11:00 P.M., Lake Ozark Police responded to a “shots fired” call on the Bagnell Dam Strip. Two unknown subjects had been asked to leave an establishment and fired 6 rounds into the air as they left in a vehicle. There were no injuries and no property damage.

An area broadcast to law enforcement was put out with a vehicle description and approximately 4 hours later, Osage Beach Police Department located the suspect vehicle at a motel in Osage Beach. After further investigation, the 2 subjects being sought were located in an apartment on Horseshoe Bend, by the Camden County Sheriff’s Department. The two subjects were taken into custody and the 9mm handgun believed to be used in the shots fired call was located. Subjects were arrested and held at Lake Ozark Police Department.

The investigation is ongoing and charges will be filed by the Miller County Prosecutor once all information is collected and reports completed.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol, Osage Beach Police Department, and Miller and Camden County Sheriff’s Departments all assisted.
